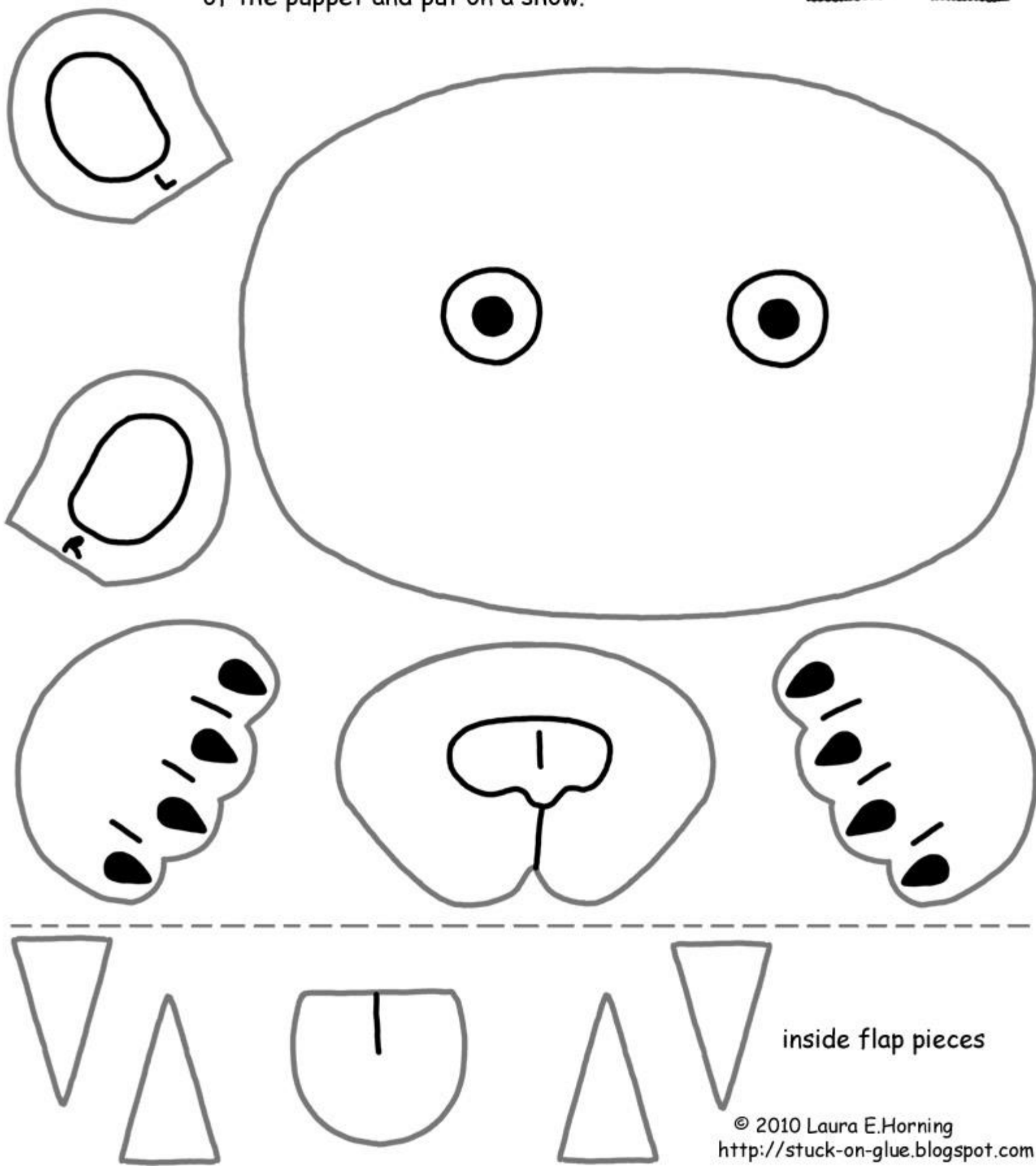
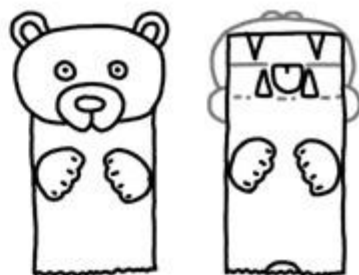

Paper Bag Puppet: Polar Bear (or any bear really)

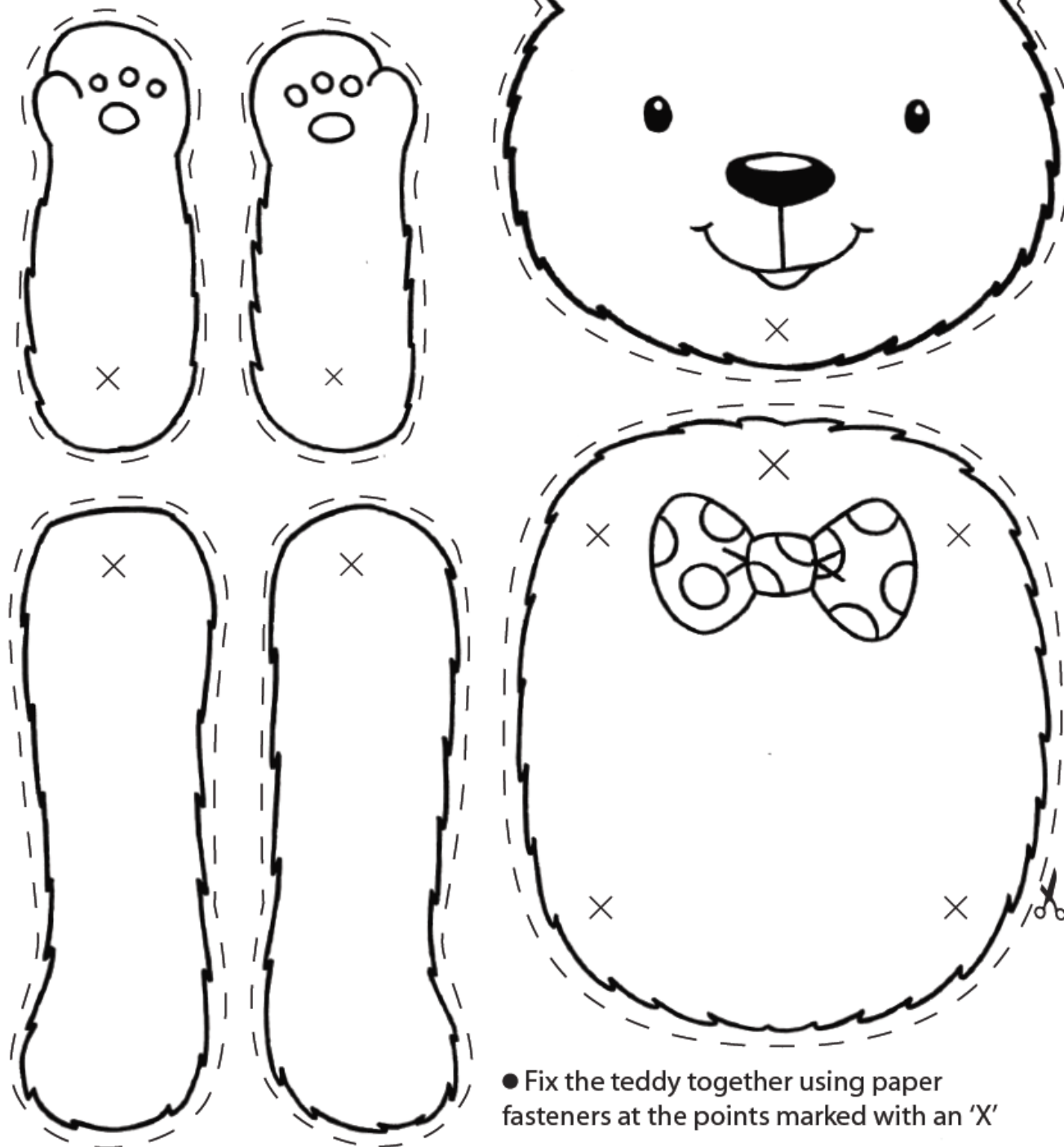
